DTO also informed that in Morigaon district 99% people wear helmets including pillion riders.

Works under SDRF scheme is expected to be completed by 15th January, 2022. Under SOPD-G scheme, construction of Sluice Gate at Matiparbat of Killing-Kopili junction is also started.
