The meeting was chaired by Deputy Commissioner, Morigaon. At the very outset, the Deputy Commissioner, Morigaon, welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

Initiating the discussion, the CEO, Zila Parishad informed about the visit of the spot study tour of the Committee on Public Account, Assam Legislative Assembly on 21st September, 2022 in Morigaon district. The Deputy Commissioner urged to all the concerned departments to participate & take significant & important schemes only and submit the report and route map of proposed inspection sites, in hard and softcopy along with PPT within two days to the planning branch of DC's Office Morigaon. He also emphasized to do convergence of all departments schemes for the convenience and time management.
