The meeting of District Development Committee (DDC) was held on 21/01/2023 at 11:00 AM in the Community Hall Burgaon, near Burgaon G.P Office, Morigaon. The meeting was chaired by Deputy Commissioner, Morigaon. At the onset, the Deputy Commissioner, Morigaon, welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

DRDA/ Zilla Parishad	<p>The CEO, Zila Parishad, Morigaon informed that :-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Under PMAY(G) Scheme (Old PWL), 89.04% houses have been completed so far in Morigaon district. 2. Under Burgaon G.P, out of total 894 nos., 881 nos. of houses have been sanctioned so far. 3. Under AWAS+ Scheme, total 510 nos. of houses have been sanctioned so far. 	CEO, Zilla Parishad, Morigaon
PWD (Building)	<p>The Executive Engineer informed that :-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Physical progress of Model Degree College in Kushtoli is 59% and the remaining portion will be completed by March 2023. 2. For Model Residential School at Alisinga, the academic building is 40% completed, Principal quarter is 50% and Kitchen-dining hall is 86% completed. The completion target is December, 2023. 3. Physical progress of Morigaon H.S & MP School is 35% so far and the remaining works will be completed by April, 2024. 4. The Chairman reiterated the E.E to install sign board at all projects where honorable CM has laid foundation stone during his visit on 8/12/2022 & shall be completed in the next 15 days. 	<p>5. Chairman told the E.E that extension of proposed Jungal Balahu building at 1st floor of the circuit house which was to be completed long back, will now have to be completed as soon as possible.</p> <p>6. The E.E informed that earth filling work is going on for the Medical College at Boghora and from 28th January work will go on full swing. In this regard, Chairman asked to take a look & work on the proper discharge of sewage water from Medical College campus.</p>	
PWD(NH)	<p>The Executive Engineer informed that :-</p> <p>1. For balance work of the construction of bridge over river Kopili in Jagiroad-Morigaon road, the sinking work for existing well foundation is in progress. The likely date of completion is 28th May, 2024.</p>	EE, PWD(NH), Morigaon
PWD(Roads)	<p>The Executive Engineer informed that:-</p> <p>1. The sinking of bitumen roads during flood season is the primary reason for their subsidence. To solve the problem, the existing bitumen roads need to be replaced by ICBP blocks.</p> <p>2. A 2.3 km long CC block road from Burgaon to Boramari has been sanctioned.</p> <p>3. Under PMGSY-II, the Murkata bridge construction is facing accessibility issue due to erosion. In this regard, Chairman asked to prepare a roadmap of the entire Murkata area for completion of the embankment before the approaching rainy season.</p> <p>4. Under PMGSY-II, Laharighat to Moritoli RCC bridge is 100% completed.</p> <p>5. Chairman asked for regular enforcement by DTO, to check the trucks overloaded with construction materials. He also directed the Forest Department to look at the source from where the materials are being loaded.</p> <p>6. Under APART project- Market modernization in Boghora is 82% completed, Buraburi market is 31% completed and Nellie market will be completed by 31st March, 2023.</p> <p>7. The construction of Kanphola to Nayanpur road has started, while 75 Meter long RCC bridge from 1 No.</p>	EE, PWD (Roads), Morigaon

	<p>Burgaon to Kaurihagi has been sanctioned.</p> <p>8. Chairman asked to involve the local people during project implementation, construction activities under APART so that awareness is generated among them. He also asked for involvement of senior officers during project activities.</p>	
Agriculture	<p>The District Agriculture Officer(DAO) informed that :-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Under Burgaon G.P, 1 no. of Tractor, 1 no of Trailer and 7 nos. of solar equipped irrigation machines are distributed so far. But there is a requirement of 50 diesel machines for irrigation in the area. 2. To solve the fertilizer problem of Burgaon area, the retailers of Jhargaon area will have to provide fertilizer to farmers. 3. Under PMKSY, Sprinkler and Drip irrigation facilities are required and also mechanization needs to be upgraded. 4. Chairman asked to increase interaction among farmers, so that they can opt for co-operative farming methods. Also, there should be a proper market linkage. He also asked to take a look at paddy procurement and set a target on monthly basis for farmer's registration. 	DAO, Morigaon
Agri. Engineering	<p>The Assistant Executive Engineer informed that:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Out of total 770 nos., 485 nos. of solar irrigation system have been received so far. 2. For FPC, Godown and Cold storage facilities are required. In this regard, Chairman asked to set up food processing centers and cold storages as well. 3. The ADO office will be completed within January, 2023. 	EE, Agri. Engineering(Raha)
PHE	<p>The Executive Engineer informed that:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Retrofitting work under Jal Jeevan Mission is going on and target for Burgaon area is 339 nos. 2. Chairman expressed his dissatisfaction over the sluggish progress of JJM mission and directed the EE to complete connection work in Jagiroad area within next 15 days. 	EE, PHE, Morigaon
Water Resources	<p>The Assistant Executive Engineer informed that :-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Under Burgaon pilot project, porcupine construction completed so far. 2. Chairman asked the AEE about the strategy for 	EE, Water Resources, Morigaon

Education	<p>The Inspector of Schools informed that:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The process is going on for smooth conduct of Gunotsav, 2023, which will be conducted from 15th to 18th February. 2. She also informed about the ongoing land issues related to KGBV, Moirabari. In this regard, CEO told that land documents along with a letter may be sent through Circle Officer, Bhuragaon & Laharighat to ADC, Revenue. 3.
