The meeting of District Development Committee (DDC) was held on 16/11/2022 at 02:00 PM in the Conference Hall of Deputy Commissioner office, Morigaon. The meeting was chaired by Deputy Commissioner, Morigaon. At the very outset, the Deputy Commissioner, Morigaon, welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

Initiating the discussion, the Chairman reviewed the action taken in the earlier meeting of DDC and the following decisions were taken: -

DRDA/ Zila Parishad	 Dy. CEO, Zila Parishad, Morigaon informed that:- 1. Under MGNREGS total 22339 nos. of scheme have been taken up, 316 nos. of schemes completed so far and remaining schemes are ongoing for the year 2022-23. 2. 87.25% of houses have been constructed in Morigaon district under PMAY-G scheme. 3. He also informed that, CEO has visited the sites allotted for landless beneficiaries in the area between Nellie & Dakshin Dharamtul. 	CEO, Zilla Parishad
PWD, Territorial Roads	The Executive Engineer, PWD, Territorial Road Division, Morigaon, informed that: 1. Under PMGSY-I only one scheme is remaining to be completed. In this regard EE, PWD (T. Road) assured to complete it by December, 2022. He also informed that, 3 nos. of bridges in Chandrapur Dev. Block and one bridge in Laharighat will be completed by March and January, 2023, respectively. 2. Chairman instructed the EE, PWD (T. Road) to clear all potholes in approaching roads of DC Office and also instructed to fix the water logging problem in Civil Hospital road before the rainy season. 3. EE, PWD (T. Road) informed that, Morisuti bridge has been eroded by river. 4. He also requested for District Administration's help for widening of Morigaon-Posotia-Domal road and Dandua Dharamtul road during land acquisition. 5. He informed about the problem arising due to lying of Jal Jeevan Mission pipe near the Japori-Gerua road. In this regard, Chairman asked the EE, PWD (T. Road) to coordinate with the PHE department. 6. Chairman also emphasized to give more importance in connectivity sector, as it is one of the key sectors for overall development of the district. So, he requested all the Officers to give their 100% effort.	

	The Assistant Executive Engineer, PWD (Building) informed that:-	
PWD (Building)	1. Earth filling has been going on in proposed Medical College & Hospital campus at Baghara. But due to forest regulation, extraction of Hill Earth has not been possible, so it will take time to complete the earth work. In this regard Chairman asked the Assistant Executive Engineer, PWD (Building) to coordinate with the Forest Range Officer, Morigaon and appraise the matter to Deputy Commissioner and open a WhatsApp group immediately. Chairman also asked the tentative date for lying foundation stone of Medical College, so that District Administration may invite Hon'ble Chief Minister for the same. In this regard, AE informed that, only after December 15 it may be possible. 2. He also informed that notice has been served to the contractor to complete the remaining work of Morigaon Circuit House. 3. Chairman enquired about the sluggish progress of Barapujia H.S. school. In this regard, AEE stated that, existing building has to be dismantled before starting of the new construction work. 4. Model B.Ed. College in Nellie is 100% completed and handing over the Institute to SCERT is under process. Model Degree College in Kushtoli is 41%, Model residential school at Alisinga is 63% completed. Jagiroad IB is 89% completed, in this connection, Chairman asked the Officer to take initiative and coordinate with the contractor, so that work can be completed by this year. He also instructed to maintain the physical progress with time. 5. Chairman asked the AEE to complete the ancillary work of ICUs at Civil Hospital Morigaon and he also learned that, contractor is not willing to complete the work as it was not part of plan & provision. Education	 Inspector of schools informed that: - DISE verification for the academic year 2022-23 has been started. Approval of all 118 nos. of SMDCs has been completed. School dropout children have been streamlined in nearby schools and KGVB. Chairman enquired about toilet less school in the district. In this regard, IS informed that, 103 nos. of school have dysfunctional toilets. Chairman also asked to provide barriers in girls' toilet immediately. 	DEEO & IS, Morigaon
Water Resources	 Asst. EE, Water Resources informed that:- Progress of all schemes under NABARD RIDF, SOPD-G has been stagnant due to rainy season and remaining works will be started as soon as possible. Under SOPD-FDR, 2 months will be required for completion of A/E measures to protect F/E along Kollong river from Raha to Jagi (R/B) at Saruati, Naramari & Tengaguri area and land related problem for construction of T/dyke along Right bank of river Killing from Ouguri to NH-Way is settled and work will be started as soon as possible. Health	 Chairperson highlighted the drainage problem and instructed the Joint Director of Health Services to look after the garbage dumping site near Civil Hospital toilet. Chairperson instructed the CEO, APDCL and EE, PWD (T. Roads) to shift the transformer near civil hospital area. He also advised JDHS to utilise Covid Infrastructure in other purposes. Social Welfare	 District Social Welfare Officer informed that:- Out of 28 model AWCs, 22 nos. have been completed and remaining will be completed within 2-3 months. Under Supplementary Nutrition Programme (SNP), Rs. 7,74,95,818 has been utilized out of fund received Rs. 8,32,09,579 for the year 2022-23 and balance fund is available at the State Nodal Account. In October, 2022, under POSHAN Abhiyaan, total 107599 nos. of children (0-5 yrs) have been screened and total 290 nos. of children are identified with SAM and they have been enrolled under CMAM. Total 21 nos. of cases have been registered under One Stop Centre in October, 2022. In this regard Chairperson, asked the DSWO to follow up all the cases after released from the centre. He also asked to file FIR against some of the accused persons. 	DSWO, Morigaon
Soil Conservation	Soil Conservation Ranger informed that:- 1. Out of 4 contour bund, construction of 2 bunds have been started and remaining 2 are yet to be started under Morigaon-WDC-1 PMKSY (KUMOI) 2.0.	DO, Soil Consevation Nagaon
Fishery	 District Fishery Development Officer informed that:- Under PMMSY, tentative target of 2 nos. hatchery, 110 nos. small ponds, 80 nos. medium/big ponds have been received on 9th November, 2022 from the directorate of Fishery. Publicity is done and after survey DLC will be formed. DFDO informed that, fish breeding has been done at Jungal Bolohu and 1 lakh seedling are ready for sowing in Killing river at Sitajakhala and in Kapili river near Jagi Bkakatgaon on 28th November, 2022. He also informed that, electricity connection has been provided by the Fishery department at Governors adopted centre at Dalbari. In this regard, DDC asked the DFDO to coordinate with other departments to utilize the space and requested HoDs of other departments to conduct training session at the centre. Sericulture	Assistant Director of Sericulture informed that: 1. Production of Eri Raw Silk is 12 MT and Muga Raw Silk is 0.02 MT during this month. Mulberry production is less due infection of the Flecherie diseases during the larval period. 2. She also informed that, Beneficiary selection to be done for model villages. In this regard DDC also urged to take more convergence schemes in villages under PMAGY and AAGY.	ADS, Morigaon/ All HoDs, Morigaon
DI&CC	The Asst. General Manager, DICC informed that: - 1. As of now, total 108 nos. of application have been received and 90 nos. of proposals have been sponsored to the bank and 11 nos. application sanctioned by bank under PMEGP scheme.	GM, DI&CC, Morigaon



	2. Under APART, foundation stone of Common Facility Centre (CFC) at Laharighat has been laid down with project cost of Rs. 3.16 Cr and Monitoring Committee has been formed.	
LABOUR	District Labour Officer informed that: 1. It is mandatory to have separate contract license for individual department. She has requested HoDs of other departments to take necessary action regarding this matter. 2. She requested HoDs of other departments to inform about cess collection to the labour department as well. 3. She also urged all the works departments to take initiative of awareness campaign for registration of carpenters, plumbers, masons etc. for pension after 60 years. 4. For registration of unorganized labours on E-Sharam portal, Morigaon district is ranked at 5th position in the state. In this regard, Chairperson asked all the departments to submit the list of unorganized labour to the office of District Labour Officer and also asked the Labour Officer to send weekly updated list of unorganized labour to the ADC (Dev.). 5. She also explained about PM Shram Yogi Mandhan Yojana and urged everyone to adopt at least one casual labour of age between 18-40 years.	Labour Officer/ All HoDs, Morigaon
Animal Husbandry & Veterinary	District Veterinary Officer informed that:- 1. Under Rashtriya Gokul Mission, 48% of Artificial Insemination is done so far in the year 2022-23. 2. 150 nos. of farmers are getting 40 poultry each under National Livestock Mission. 3. Scrutiny is going on for a project at Sitajakhala.	DVO, Morigaon
Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs	Chairperson asked the Inspector of Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs about the anomalies of 6000 quintal rice and prepares a water tight case against the person involved in this act. In this regard, the Inspector informed that, 4 nos. of shop owners have been suspended.	ADS, Morigaon

Last but not the least; the Chairman requested all concerned Heads of Developments Deptts. to start the restoration work in a war footing manner. He asked the officials from PWD (NH) to provide speed breakers in Baghara area and also asked to pursue with NHAI for providing speed breakers in Dharamtul Bishnu mandir and inform the Deputy Commissioner within one week.
