The meeting of District Development Committee (DDC) was held on 24/03/2022 at 11:00 AM in the Conference Hall of Deputy Commissioner office, Morigaon. The meeting was Chaired by Deputy Commissioner, Morigaon. At the onset the Deputy Commissioner, Morigaon, welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

Centrally sponsored schemes will be completed before 31st March, 2022. 	<p>completed.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Under NLCPR, for the year 2012-13, Manipur Tup bridge is yet to be completed. In this regard Chairperson asked to complete the project as soon as possible. 5. Under Assam Mala project, Chairperson asked the EE to take up the process immediately and for land acquisition matter may be discuss with ADC (Revenue). He also advised to do drone survey before starting of the project. 6. Construction of drain under signature project in Morigaon has been completed. Chairperson told the EE that, quality of work is not satisfactory and asked to check free flow of drain before the releasing of final bill. Another signature project (road) in Laharighat is almost 80% completed. 7. For the year 2018-19, 2 bridges have been completed & construction of 3 bridges are going on and for the year 2020-21, 1 bridge has been completed & construction of another 3 bridges are going on. In this regard, Chairperson asked the EE to complete the work in a war footing manner. 8. Under SOPD, Basanaghat to Bhurgaon road is yet to be completed. EE assured that, within one month they will complete the remaining work. 9. Under CM special package, 3 nos. of roads and 2 nos. of bridges have been completed out of 5 nos. of bridges. 10. 7 nos. of roads are completed out 14 nos. under Assam Darshan scheme. 11. SCSP: - 20 projects have been completed and 4 are going on. 12. TSP: - 5 projects have been completed. 13. SDRF: - 49 roads and 9 bridges have been completed under this scheme. 14. Under Fakaruddin Ali Ahmed Paki Path Nirman Achoni, 3 roads have been completed. 15. Under PMGSY, 199 roads have been completed out of 207 roads. Excluding bridges, remaining roads will be completed on or before 31st March, 2022. 	
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Agriculture	<p>The Executive Engineer, Agriculture, Morigaon informed that: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Data of 4054 eligible beneficiaries under PM KISAN will be uploaded shortly. Chairperson asked the DAO to verify remaining beneficiaries as soon as possible so that maximum people can get the benefits of this scheme under Morigaon district. 2. Under PMKSY 189.9 hectares. agricultural land has been irrigated out of 500 hectares. Chairperson asked the DAO to immediately cover up remaining target. 3. Market under APART 3rd phase, out of 4 nos. of projects, 3 nos. namely Baghara market, Mayong daily weekly market, Buraburi daily weekly market are under construction, on the other hand Moirabari daily weekly market is under bidding process. 4. Chairperson informed that, there is anomalies regarding actual production and surplus of Khali and Bao paddy in Morigaon district. In this regard DC asked the DAO, to do real time assessment of production and surplus of paddy, which will eventually help during paddy procurement. 5. Chairperson also asked to procure Soil Health Card data as soon as possible. 	DAO, Morigaon
PWD (Building)	<p>Junior Engineer, PWD (Building) informed that,</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. One Stop Centre in Morigaon civil hospital, sports building and Tea garden school in Gopal Krishna were handed over to their respective departments. 2. Polytechnic college, RTPCR lab are 100% completed. On the other hand, Tiwa Autonomous Council building is 40%, Model degree college is 28% and B.Ed. college is 90% completed. 3. Documentation of LMO tank is yet to be completed, though 100% physical work has been done. 4. Junior Engineer also informed that, 12 bedded hospital will be completed by 31st March and IB Jagiroad building is almost completed except electrical work. 5. Chairperson also inquired about the sluggish progress of Circuit House building. In this regard DC asked the engineer to serve notice to the concerned contractor and 	EE, PWD (Building), Morigaon

PHE	<p>The Executive Engineer, PHE, Morigaon informed that: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Under JJM scheme till now 111% FHTC completed in Morigaon district and 7 nos. of newly sanctioned schemes are 20% (average) completed. 2. Water facility in schools/Anganwadi centers under JJM's 100 day campaign, overall 767 schemes out of 1308 in schools and 278 schemes out of 1743 in Anganwadi centers till February, 2022 have been completed. In this regard Chairperson asked the EE to speed up the remaining work. He also asked the EE to reconcile the actual data of school & AWC electrification with APDCL, Inspector of School and Social Welfare department. 3. The EE informed that, water testing in lab under JJM has been completed. He also informed that, solid/plastic waste management system in Mayong Block is going on and land is not available in Mikrbheta circle for this purpose. Target for sample testing through FTK for the FY 2021-22 is 17,000 numbers. Total achieved and uploaded in IMIS during FY 2021-22 is 13815 numbers and will be completed by 31st March, 2022. 4. From Jan, 2022 to March, 2022, more than twenty-nine thousand (29000) covid test have been done and 1819 persons were found positive. But, for the time being no covid patient is present in Morigaon district. 2. Vaccination for the age group of 12 to 14 years, 92% of the total beneficiaries are vaccinated with the first doses. In this regard Chairperson asked the Jt. Director of Health to complete the remaining vaccination school wise in coordination with Inspector of Schools. 3. 78% target achieved under Janani Suraksha Yojana and 90% will be achieved by March, 2022. Chairperson asked to increase the Institutional delivery under this scheme. 4. Chairperson inquired about less numbers of beneficiaries covered under Atal Amrit Yojana and Ayushman Bharat Yojana in Morigaon district and also asked to test Oxygen plant connection properly before use. 5. To fulfill the gap, External Evaluators from Nagaon and Kamrup Metro will be accommodated for the GUNOTSAV, 2022. 2. Till now, out of 70% of text books received, 30% text books have been distributed among the students. Remaining 30% text book will be received shortly. 3.
